Installing Google Authenticator






- Installing an authenticator app on a mobile device is simple and straight forward.

Open the Google Play store app.






- Step 1:

Open the Google Play Store app on your mobile device. The Google Play Store app is indicated as a **play triangle** icon shown in the picture above.






- Step 2:

Once its open, click on the **apps section** as indicated.






Search the Google play store app for Google Authenticator






- Step 3: Type **Google Authenticator** in the search bar






- Step 4: Now your Google Authenticator App is ready to install.
- Tap **Install**.






Tap Open






- Step 5: Once the app is installed, tap **Open**





- There may be a screen asking you to login with your Google account or to use Authenticator without an account.
- You can choose either option
- It is not necessary to have a Google account to use the Google Authenticator, but using with it a Google account enables Google to synchronize your settings across multiple devices.







- If you have a Google account, tap **Accept**.
