## Installing an authenticator app on a mobile device





- Let us see how to install the Microsoft Authenticator App and use it to scan the CAFT, MFA and the QR login code.
- Steps involving downloading from play store to an Android device.
- These steps are very similar downloading from Apple store to an iOS device.

app.






- You will begin with opening a play store app from your mobile device, often indicated by the **triangle play icon**






Open the play store app






- Once its open, Click on the Apps section as indicated in the picture.




Search the play store app for MS Authenticator





- Type Microsoft Authenticator in the search bar.








- Now your Microsoft Authenticator App is ready to install.
- Tap the **Install**.






Tap Open





- Once the App is installed Tap **Open**



It is now installed and ready for use.

- Once you have installed an authenticator app on your mobile device, you are ready to begin with the MFA process.








# Setting up MS Authenticator




# Setting up MS Authenticator

- Position the QR scanner over the middle of the QR code it will automatically recognize it and create the account.




## Setting up MS Authenticator

'GOT IT'.






- Once the QR code is recognized select the option **“Got it”** .
